

## Science

This half term we will be looking at animals including humans. We will be sorting animals introducing mammals, reptiles, amphibians, birds and fish. Looking at what different animals eat and discussing carnivores, omnivores and herbivores. We will also look at the human body and the senses that go with them.

## English

We will be focusing on repetitive story structures and creating our own story based on a rescue story. The children will listen to lots of stories with repetition in like 'The little Red Hen' and then recreate their own story based on 'A Dinosaur who needed help.'

## Humanities

This term we will be looking at Dinosaurs. The children will transform into Paleontologists like the famous Mary Anning and learn all about what lived on earth a very long time ago.

We will locate where the dinosaurs roamed in the U.K in the past.

## Maths:

During this Term we will be focusing on these areas:

- Ordering numbers to 20.
- Counting, reading and writing numbers to 10.
- Addition and subtraction to 20.

## RE- Christianity

We will be focusing on friendship; our key question will be:

- Was it always easy for Jesus to show friendship?

We will be looking at friendship stories from the bible.

## ICT:

This half term they will focus on grouping and sorting.

The children will sort items by different criteria away from the computer.

At the computer, they will use Grouping on Purple Mash to sort items.

## Art/D&T

We will be become Paleontologists and dig for bones to piece together and create a dinosaur skeleton.

We will also create our very own fossils to help us to learn how we discovered dinosaurs in the first place.

## PE:

We will be focusing on Multi Skills. We will develop balance, agility and co-ordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities.
