

Science: In Summer we are going to be learning about 'Animals including Humans' as our Science topic. This is a really fun and interesting topic as we get to delve into the similarities and differences between animals and humans. We will be able to get our thinking caps on, work scientifically and take part in practical experiments.

RE: In our Summer term, we will be focusing on the religions of Christianity and Buddhism. For our Buddhism topic, we will be exploring how Buddhists can lead a good life and for our Christian topic, we will be investigating how and where Christians can worship God.

Computing: In computing this term we will be focusing on Online Safety. This topic will help us to learn about the seriousness of online safety and how we can advise ourselves and others to be safe online. We will use posters, spreadsheets, questionnaires to help us with our learning.
