- To name 10 fruits and say which fruits I like and don't like.

Maths: Place value/ Addition & Subtraction/ Multiplication & division

- Recognise the value of each digit in a 3-digit number.
- To learn strategies to add and subtract 3-digit numbers.
- To focus on multiplication facts from 3s, 4s, and 8s.
